Fisheries test in Lough Carra

The Inland Fisheries Trust will next week place 300 tagged brown trout in Lough Carra, Co. Mayo. The trout will be taken from the State hatchery at Roscrea in aerated tanks and will be released in different parts of the lake. The object is to find out if there is a migration of trout from that lake; also to find the rate of growth of trout there. Since the Inland Fisheries Trust began operations at Lough Carra last September over 2,000 adult pike and over 5,000 adult perch have been removed.
