LIFE Concept Note

We have just received wonderful news that the Concept Note submitted for the LIFE Project has been accepted. This means that we can now proceed to the stage of submitting a full proposal for a LIFE project. This next stage is a very important and significant task which has to be completed by 15 February 2021 - so there is lots more work to be done.

We are extremely grateful to all the agencies that have supported this project so far, especially Mayo Co Co who are the lead agency and all the supporting parties which include NPWS, Dept Agriculture, IFI, LawPro, GSI, EPA and many others.
