

Minutes of meeting held in Welcome Inn Hotel on 4th July 1975, Mr J. J. Jordan as chairman. Present were Mr J. O'Connor, T. Maguire, J. O'Reilly, L. Scott, S. de Barra, A. Mullaney, M. Corcoran, J.
