

Minutes of Meeting held in Welcome Inn Hotel on Friday 3rd July 1981.

The Chairman said that the main business was to arrange for the July Competition. Mr T. Baynes proposed 19th July & this was seconded by L. Scott.

The Chairman then pointed out that there had been talk of alleged irregularities in previous competitions, particularly the May Competition. The Committee decided on the following rules after much discussion, prop. by T. Maguire, sec. by J. Jobson.

- (1) Competition to be fished on east side of lake from Flannerys Bay to Blousehall - no fishing west of but at Derrineush
- (2) Only one starting point, West Twin Island.
- (3) Competitors must arrange their own boat accommodation
- (4) Competitors must sign entry sheets and pay entry fee at starting point before start of competition
- (5) Competitors to be at starting point at 11 am. and competition starts at 11³⁰ or as committee decides
- (6) All boats must be beached on West Twin Island at 6³⁰ pm. for weigh in
- (7) All fish must measure at least 12 inches (Note: Any angler bringing in undersized fish is liable to prosecution)
- (8) All competitors fish at their own risk
- (9) The Officers and Committee of L. Barra Trout Anglers Assn will not be responsible for accidents or loss.
- (10) The Committee's decision in all matters relating to the competition shall be final
- (11) The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries



- (12) Only 3 rods per boat permitted. Casting with wet
fly, dry fly and dapping allowed
- (13) Trolling will not be allowed. Anyone found

Trotting flies or baits or spinning baits will be disqualified. Having read the rules competitors must sign the circular and hand it to the stewards before the start of the competition, otherwise they cannot compete.

The Sec. reported on a planning application by P. Corbett, Moorhall to build a house at Ballycally the septic tank to be 75ft. from high water mark. After a discussion it was decided to lodge an objection to be consistent.

Mr R. De Barra reported on the drainage situation & also on the stocking that had taken place on the lake since spring. This concluded the business of the meeting
